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Guidance

Although we advise that you consult a solicitor or will writer before altering the terms of your will, you can alter the terms of your current will using our document – called a Codicil.

Do not try to alter the terms of your current will by making deletions or adding provisions by writing on the will as the changes may not be valid

Our Codicil is provided to be of assistance to you and allows you to leave a cash gift to ME Research. Your solicitor or will writer will be able to help if you wish to bequeath to us part of the residue of your estate or a reversionary interest rather than a cash bequest.

Please complete this Codicil in *ink* by filling in the following details –

1. Your full name – including any middle name
2. Your full address
3. Indicate if this is the first or second codicil to your will
4. The date your current will was signed
5. The amount you are kind enough to bequeath to us expressed in figures and then in words

Once you completed the details, are happy with the document and that you understand the document, please sign and have your signature witnessed by *two* witnesses.

Your witnesses need to sign the document, provide their full names and addresses, their occupation and complete the date signed.

The witnesses *must* be present when you sign the Codicil and should sign and complete their details in your presence and together.

Neither you current Executors or any of your beneficiaries (or their spouses) should act as a witnesses. Your witnesses must be over the age of eighteen.

Once the Codicil is completed, signed and witnessed, please place the codicil with your current will or send it to the person who looks after your will e.g. your solicitor
